VETERANS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND LEGISLATIVE BREAKFAST PROJECT

The Riverside County **Veterans' Advisory Committee** (VAC) was established by the Board of Supervisors in July 1979 to:

1. Keep the Board apprised of problems and issues facing veterans.
2. Serve as a support group for the Riverside National Cemetery.
3. Act as liaison between veterans and the County Veteran Service Officer.
4. Help unify Veteran Service Organizations (VSOs).
5. Assist veterans and keep the public aware of problems and needs of veterans.

The "**Legislative Breakfast**" is a project of the Riverside County Veterans' Advisory Committee and the Riverside County Department of Veterans' Services. Guest speakers include local community leaders, VA officials, Local, County, State and Federal elected and appointed officials, Veteran Service Organizations leaders, etc.; who present information on a wide range of topics that serve and/or impact Veterans, their families and the community. Distinguished guests provide updates on laws, bills, projects and services, support, etc. The Legislative Breakfast is "open to the public" and starts at 8am at different venues throughout Riverside County on the second Friday of the month. Speaking and Q&A lasts about one hour. Attendance is free and averages 25-30. Meals are no host/individual pay.
